

HOW TO FIND RESOURCES

01. Identify Your Topic

Using the course outline and any other course planning materials, identify the topic or topics covered.

Identify the keywords that describe the topic, and any variations (e.g. data analytics, data analysis, etc.).



02. Search the UNF Library

Go to the [UNF Library website](#) and click “Search” to open the Advanced Search interface. Enter your keywords and click “Search”.

Use the limiters under the search bar on the results page to limit your results (e.g. click “Source Type” and select “eBooks” to limit your search to ebooks).

03. Search OER Repositories

Go to the [OER LibGuide](#) and search the OER Repositories.

Recommended repositories:
Pressbooks, DOAB, Open Research Library, OAPEN

04. Search the Web

Search the web for your keywords followed by “open access book”.



Tips:

When searching for resources in OER repositories or on the web, always check for the licensing or permissions to ensure its use is allowable under copyright. If no copyright information can be found on the document or on the host site, it may not be a legal copy.
